A summertime parking update:

Everyone's favorite topic – parking! If you park on campus you likely already know that parking is being enforced all summer long. If you are planning to purchase a parking permit for the coming year – here are a few things to know:

- “A” lot parking permits for State Classified employees will be the same price this coming year as last year (\$442/year) (Other employees will be paying \$565/year). CSU Administration is covering this cost since State Classified employees did not receive a raise for FY17.
- Parking permits are discounted 50% for all employees who earn up to or below \$35,000/year. If you are a full-time employee and earn \$35,000/year or less – when you go to purchase your parking permit, this 50% discount will be automatic.
- And, if you want a \$250/year parking permit option – you can purchase a permit specific to Lot #740, the Research Blvd. parking lot for \$250. If you buy this permit, this is the only lot your parking permit will be valid for. Save some \$, park here, and ride the [Around the Horn](#) shuttle to campus.
