As Associate Provost for Educational Attainment, Dr. Lamborn works under the Provost's direction to facilitate interdivisional collaborations that promote enhanced student learning, increased retention and graduation rates, and higher overall levels of degree attainment. As Executive Director of the Reinvention Center, Dr. Lamborn serves as the principal administrative officer for a national consortium of research universities dedicated to advancing undergraduate education.

Before assuming his current roles, Dr. Lamborn served as Vice Provost for Undergraduate Affairs from 2005-2013 and Associate Dean of the College of Liberal Arts from 1999-2005. A professor of political science who specializes in world politics, Dr. Lamborn has been a faculty member at Colorado State University since 1984. He has served on curriculum committees at every level of the university and participated in many task forces at the university and within the state charged with issues related to student learning, course transferability, and timely graduation. He was elected as the faculty's representative to the governing board of Colorado State University in 1997 and 1998. He received his M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of Michigan and his B.A. from Oberlin College.
